Background and Basic Description of the Requirement: The Customer has Local Area Networks at each location comprised of Cisco network equipment (internal connections) that enable the school sites to communicate and access the Internet. Additionally, the District utilizes distance learning technology to expand the learning opportunities of its students. The Customer requires basic maintenance support in the form of technicians and manufacturer maintenance contracts for the network and distance learning equipment to ensure the network connections and distance learning environment continue to function and serve their intended purposes with the degree of reliability ordinarily provided in the marketplace. Cisco SMARTnet and Tandberg maintenance services are being sought to facilitate the effective operability of the Cisco network equipment and Tandberg distance learning equipment.

SPECIFICATIONS

The Customer is seeking a maintenance contract to purchase technician maintenance and equipment Maintenance required to maintain E-Rate Eligible Cisco network equipment and Tandberg distance learning equipment. The Customer will use the pricing provided in the selected vendor contract to purchase manufacturer maintenance deemed necessary during the term of the contract.

Contract will be awarded for a period of (July 1, 2015 – June 30, 2018) with the school system contingent upon approval E-Rate funding on an annual basis. Options will be executed at the Customer's discretion provided pricing same as originally agreed upon, vendor continues to meet all other requirements, the System continues to be funded through the E-Rate program, and when executing the Options does not violate bid laws or E-Rate guidelines.

Bidders must be a valid E-Rate provider with an approved SPIN provided with the bid.

Basic maintenance: E-Rate Definition of Basic Maintenance Eligibility: Basic Maintenance services are "necessary" if but for the maintenance at issue, the connection would not function and serve its intended purpose with the degree of reliable ordinarily provided in the marketplace to entities receiving such services without E-Rate discounts. Basic maintenance services do not include services that maintain equipment that is not supported or that enhance the utility of equipment beyond the transport of information or diagnostic services in excess of those necessary to maintain the equipment ability to transport information.

Basic maintenance is eligible for discount only if it is a component of a maintenance agreement or contract for the services or products, and these maintenance services are cost effective. The agreement or contract must specifically identify the eligible Products or services covered, including product name, model number, and location.

Vendor must have verifiable accounts and provide references for a minimum of 3 other customers for whom company has provided similar size and scope of services under E-Rate funded contracts.

Service Provider Qualifications:
